

All-Ivy Environmental Career Fair

Transportation Information:

Cornell Career Services will be providing 2 buses which can hold ~ 90 students. Seats will be filled on a first-come, first- served basis. Students will register for the buses in CCNet. The deadline to sign-up is Monday, February 23rd at 8 AM. The cost of the bus is \$35.00 and the Bursar's Office will bill the amount to your student account. The buses will leave Cornell beginning at 5:45 am and will depart from NYC at 3:00 pm sharp (**We will not wait for you if you are not there at the time the bus departs**). We should return to campus around 8:30 PM.

The cost per person is \$35.00 (even if you only take the bus one way)

Students can sign-up for a seat on the bus via CCNet starting Monday, January 12, 2015.

To sign-up, login to your CCNet account and under the "Calendar" tab, select, "Event Search." Under event type, select "Employer Workshop/Special Event." Click on the link for the "All-Ivy Environmental Career Fair Bus Sign-ups" (2/27/15). Click on "signup" to register for the bus.

The deadline to sign-up is Monday, February 23rd, 2015, 8:00 AM. If you wish to be added to the wait-list, you can sign up with Craig Jones (caj25@cornell.edu) in 103 Barnes.

Registration Information:

- You may sign-up for a seat starting on Monday, January 12th, in CCNet.
- You will be required to sign a "Hold Harmless" agreement (below). You must print and sign your name on the agreement and email (nnd5@cornell.edu) or drop it off in 201 Carpenter Hall.
- You will NOT be allowed on the bus if you don't sign the Hold Harmless agreement.

 - If you are taking the bus round trip or one-way (the cost is \$35 regardless)

Buses will leave promptly at the designated departure times. They will not wait. It is estimated that the buses will arrive at Columbia University (2920 Broadway) around 11:00 am. A rest/meal stop will be made en route each way.

There will be a Cornell staff representative on each of the buses.

AGREEMENT/RELEASE FOR STUDENT TRAVEL

1. I acknowledge that my participation in the trip to New York City with The College of Engineering, Engineering Co-op & Career Services Office, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Career Services Office, and the College of Arts and Sciences Career Services Office is entirely voluntary.
2. I understand that participation in this trip may subject me to risks relating to or arising out of the activity, including risks associated with travel to, from, and during the activity. I understand that there are inherent risks, including but not limited to the risk of crime, terrorist attack, civil disturbance, motor vehicle accident or other accident that may result in personal injury, and I agree to assume all risks and responsibility for my own conduct, health, safety, and property while participating in the activity. I further understand that should I choose to provide my own transportation to or from New York City, I am solely responsible for my actions and anything that might happen to me due to my elected arrival and/or departure times that are different from the Cornell-provided transportation. I agree that Cornell will not be responsible for any delay, injury or damage I may incur due to my choice in transportation other than that provided by Cornell.
3. I understand that during any free time while on this trip, I am responsible for myself, and am aware of the dangers that I could be exposed to (mugging, robbery, assault, etc.) and I agree to assume all such risks associated with this trip.

In consideration of my participation in this trip, I agree, on behalf of myself, my assigns, executors, and heirs, to release, indemnify, and hold harmless, Cornell University (including The College of Engineering, Engineering Co-op & Career Services Office, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Career Services Office, and the College of Arts and Sciences Career Services), its trustees, officers, agents and employees from any and all liability, damage, or claim of any nature whatsoever, including negligence, arising out of or in any way related to my participation in this trip, except for damages resulting from the gross negligence of Cornell University.
5. I understand that Cornell University does not provide any Accident or Medical Insurance and that I am required to provide my own Accident and Medical Insurance. I hereby agree that I am financially responsible for all such expenses, including expenses for any medical care that I may need while on this trip.
6. I understand that I, as a participant in this activity, am also a member of the Cornell University community and subject to Cornell University regulations, guidelines, the laws of the United States, and the laws of New York State, and that in the event of violation of any of these, Cornell University shall have the right to dismiss me from the trip and to make a referral to the Judicial Administrator if appropriate.
7. I have read and understand the terms of this Agreement and Release and agree to all terms and conditions on behalf of myself, my heirs, representatives, executors, and administrators. I hereby certify by my signature that I am physically fit and able to participate in this field trip, that I am at least 18 years of age, and that I am voluntarily signing this Agreement and Release.
