The 2009 Accepted / Applied Chart below contains Cornell-specific data. The chart may be used to estimate your chances of admission to allopathic (M.D.) medical schools. The data does not include Cornellians who applied to other health professional schools: osteopathy, dentistry, optometry, podiatry, etc.
