The 2003 Accepted/Applied chart contains Cornell-specific data. The chart may be used to estimate your chances of admission to allopathic (M.D.) medical schools. This data does not include Cornellians who applied to other health professional schools: osteopathy, dentistry, optometry, and podiatry.

There was a slight increase in the number of applicants in 2003, both at Cornell and nationally. The national accepted/applied information, which is also given, can be useful in reviewing the Cornell chart.
